Our Pinewood derby is scheduled for Saturday January 28th, 2012. Held at the Mosheim Volunteer Firehouse, on the 11E bypass.

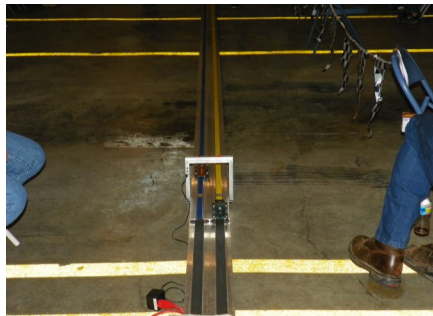
We have the Official Rules posted on the web site, direct links are at the end of this article.
