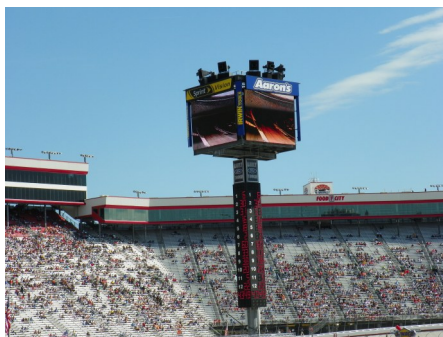
The Scout Expo is an informative, fun experience for the boys where they will get to interact with Boy Scout troops and Cub Scout packs
