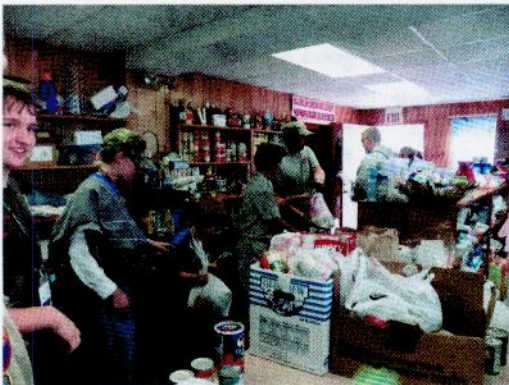
Food Drive
